POSITION DESCRIPTION



Lecturer – Physiotherapy (Cardiorespiratory) – Academic B School of Health, Medical and Applied Sciences

(To be read in conjunction with the Lecturer Level B Position Description contained within the current [Enterprise Agreement](#)).

You will:

Make contributions to the teaching effort of a school, division or other organisational unit or to an interdisciplinary area. You are expected to play a major role in teaching, research and/or professional activities. You will perform assigned teaching duties with students on and off campus with a standard of planning, preparation, presentation and assessment as necessary for students to achieve unit and course objectives. You will critically evaluate the operation of the teaching programme and communicate such evaluations to the relevant Dean / Head as appropriate.

You are responsible for:

- As a member of the program academic team, leading and participating in the delivery of foundation and profession-focused units across multiple campuses.
- Conducting tutorials, practical classes, demonstrations, workshops, student field excursions, clinical sessions and/or studio sessions.
- Initiation and development of unit material.
- Course coordination.
- The preparation and delivery of lectures and seminars.
- Supervision of the course of study of honours students or of postgraduate students engaged in unit work.
- Supervision of honours or postgraduate research projects.
- A significant role in research projects including, where appropriate, leadership of a research team.
- Involvement in professional activity.
- Development of unit material with appropriate advice from and support of more senior staff.
- Marking and assessment.
- Consultation with students.
- Broad administrative functions.
- Attendance at school and/or division meetings and undertake a major role in planning or committee work.

Selection Criteria

Essential - Registered, or eligible to be registered with the Physiotherapy Board of Australia / AHPRA. - Teaching qualification or willingness to undertake a Graduate Certificate in Tertiary Teaching / Education. - An understanding of current professional and educational issues in higher education and the ability to engage and work effectively with colleagues within the School and across the University to support students and promote CQUniversity. Desirable - Hold a postgraduate qualification or working towards a postgraduate qualification in an area relevant to physiotherapy. This will require a doctoral (PhD) or masters qualification.	Essential - Minimum 5 years' clinical experience in a hospital and/or community based health service in a relevant discipline area of cardiorespiratory physiotherapy. - Demonstrated ability to teach and supervise undergraduate University students, specifically an ability to teach in either the cardiorespiratory physiotherapy. - Demonstrated ability to engage in research in areas of research strength. - Demonstrated ability to make a positive contribution to a team culture, through effective communication and interpersonal skills. - Demonstrated capacity to engage and network effectively with industry and community partners and stakeholders. Desirable - Ability to contribute to curriculum development, writing and evaluation, particularly using flexible modes of delivery. - Ability and preparedness to participate in school and wide administrative duties. - Experience of communication with the popular media.
